


ABOUT ROBERT KENNEDY

Robert Terence Kennedy trained as an architect in Manchester and worked in the office of (later Sir) William Holford before joining the new Ministry of Town & Country Planning, working on the reconstruction of wardamaged English towns and the new town development programme. In 1951 he was awarded a CBE for this work.

He resigned from the Ministry in 1955 and had a short stint as a consultant to Holford before coming to New Zealand in 1957 to head the newly established School of Town Planning at The University of Auckland. Robert Kennedy was the first professor of town planning at the University of Auckland. He was central in establishing university-based education for planning.

ABOUT THE GRANT

Te Kōkiringa Taumata | New Zealand Planning Institute (NZPI) Robert Kennedy Research grant recognises excellence in research that achieves a world-class level of success, exemplified by the dissemination of a significant body and depth of work, through peer reviewed publications in international journals, or books, of high repute.

The grant is open to joint research projects. The grant has a value of \$2,000

JUDGING CRITERIA


- How the work has contributed to and enhanced planning in Aotearoa/New Zealand and/or the world.

- 3. How and in what ways their planning research has been recognised internationally.


The award will be formally presented at the 2024 Annual Conference in Kirikiriroa | Hamilton, 20 – 22 March 2024.
