



Cultural Dynamic - Bay of Plenty Region (May 2016)












Komiti Māori Hui Hosting at your marae

The Pau kilings may choose to hold the powhin outside on the Manas itse or within the Wharend. Kala koatou te tikanga. The powhiri is followed by a short moming tea.


