






BAU = ASSUMPTIONS = FAILURE

Maginot Line – built to defend France from threat of German invasion prior to World War II.


Assumed a direct assault along the German/French boundary.





BAU DOESN'T ADAPT TO CHANGES

On May 10 1940, Germany bypassed the Maginot Line via Luxembourg and Belgium to attack France





WE KEEP MAKING SAME MISTAKES


Singapore – December 1941 – the cornerstone of the British Empire in Southeast Asia



Aware of Japanese threat – Singapore built strong fortifications along southern coast to protect island from attack from sea. **Assumed** attack through the Malay Jungle impossible






