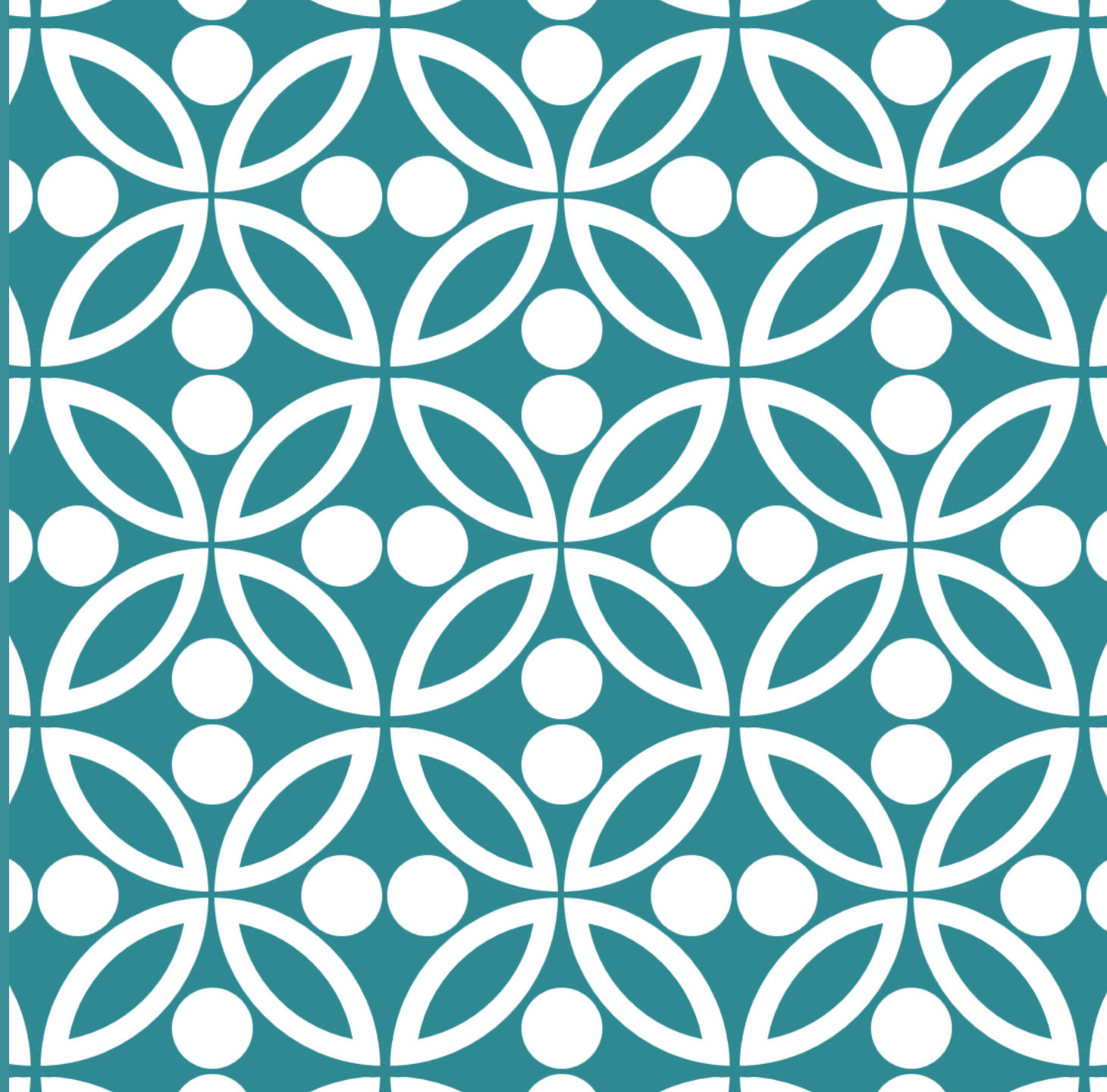

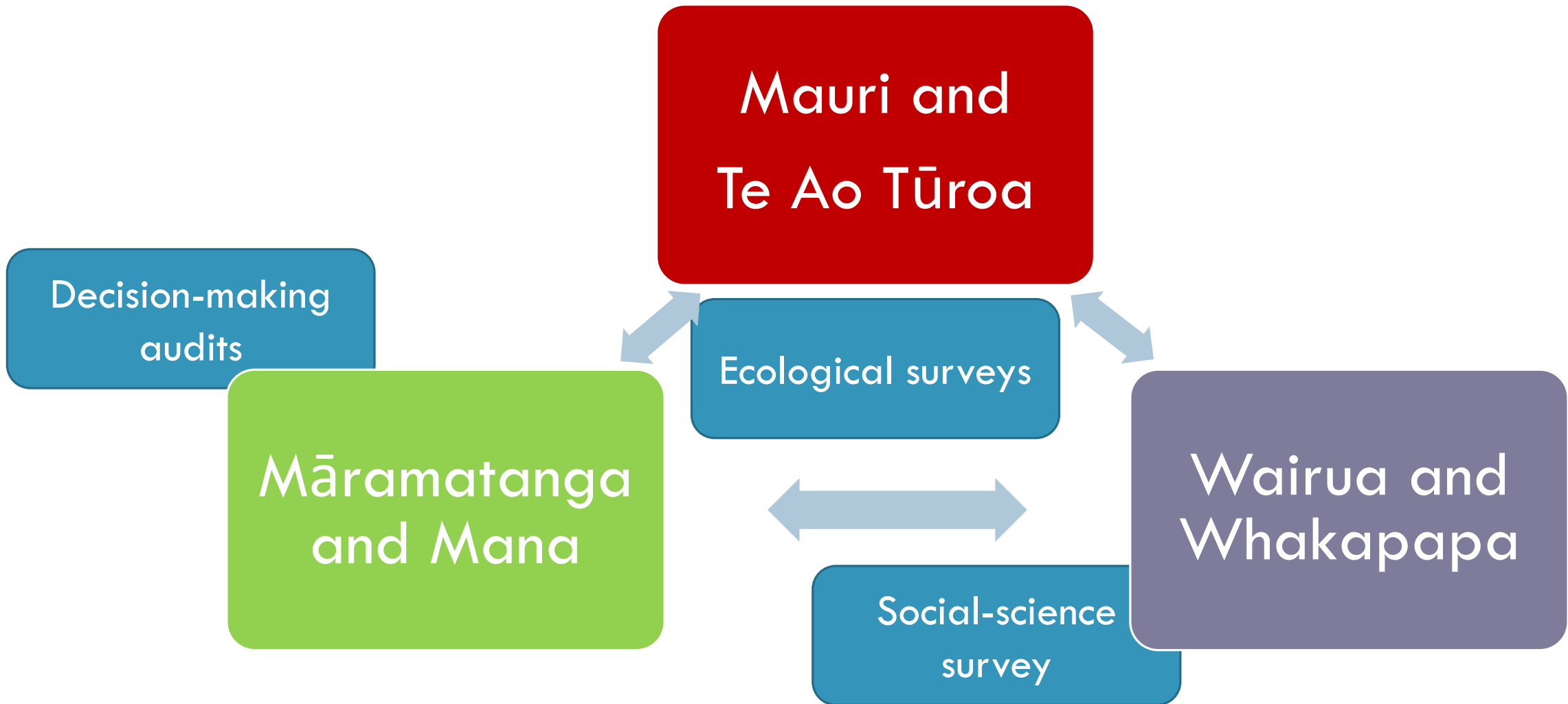
Te Mana o te Wai recognises the connection between water and the broader environment:

Te Hauora o te Taiao (the health of the environment)

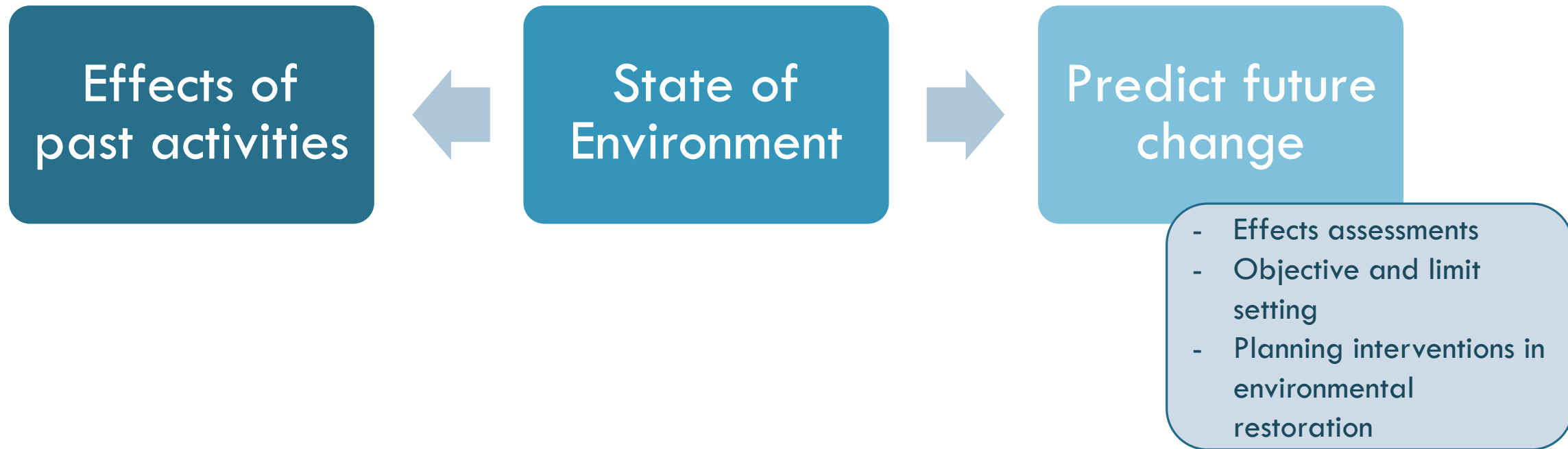
Te Hauora o te Wai (the health of the waterbody), and;

Te Hauora o te Tangata (the health of the people)

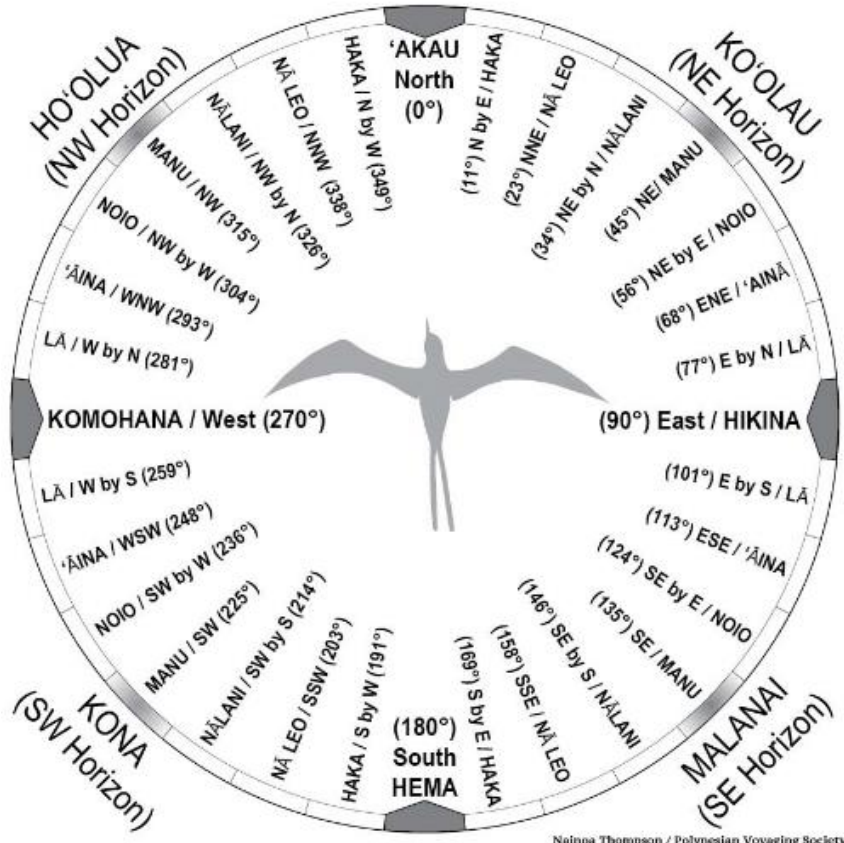

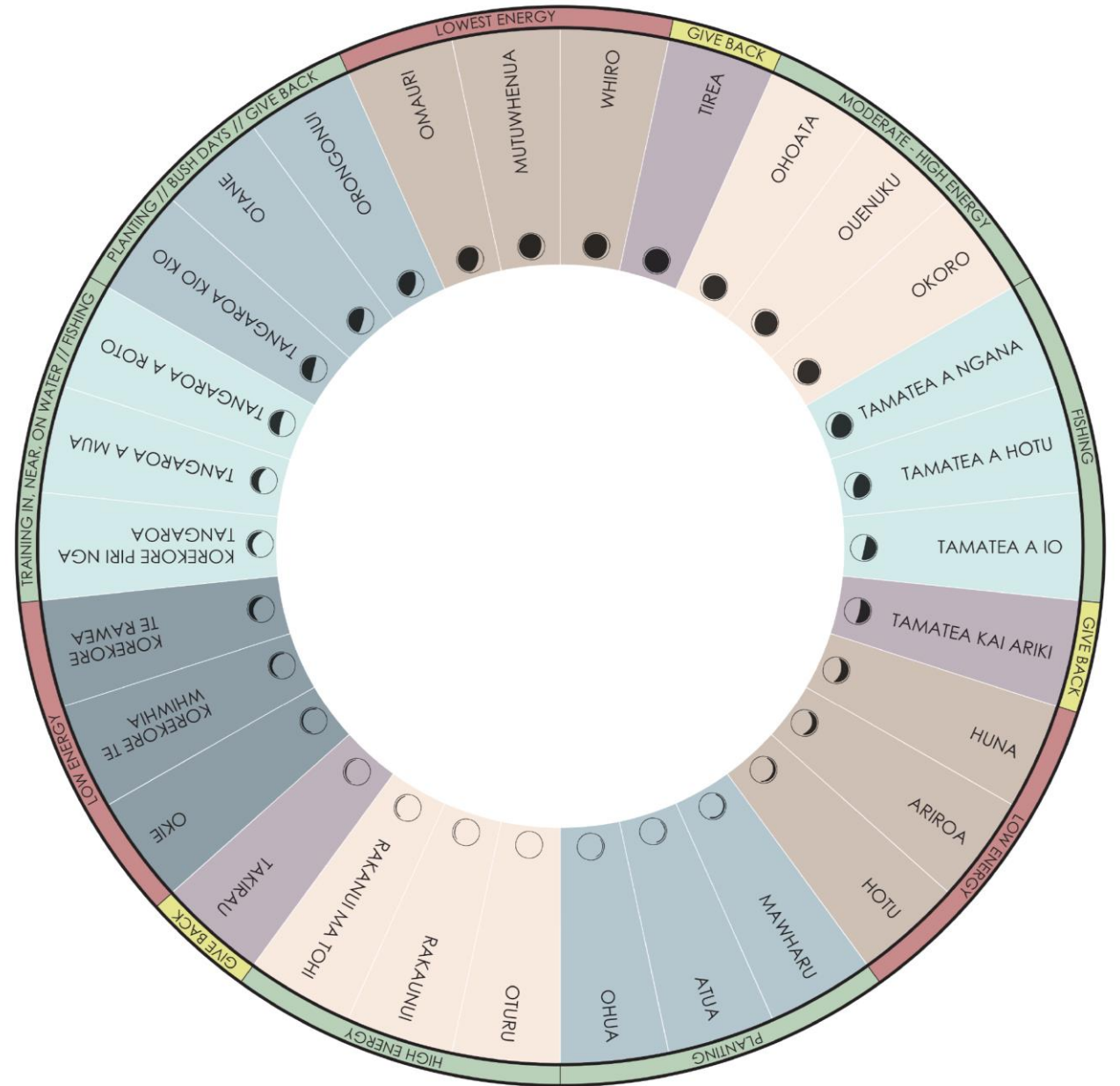
THE USE OF KAITIAKI MONITORING DATA



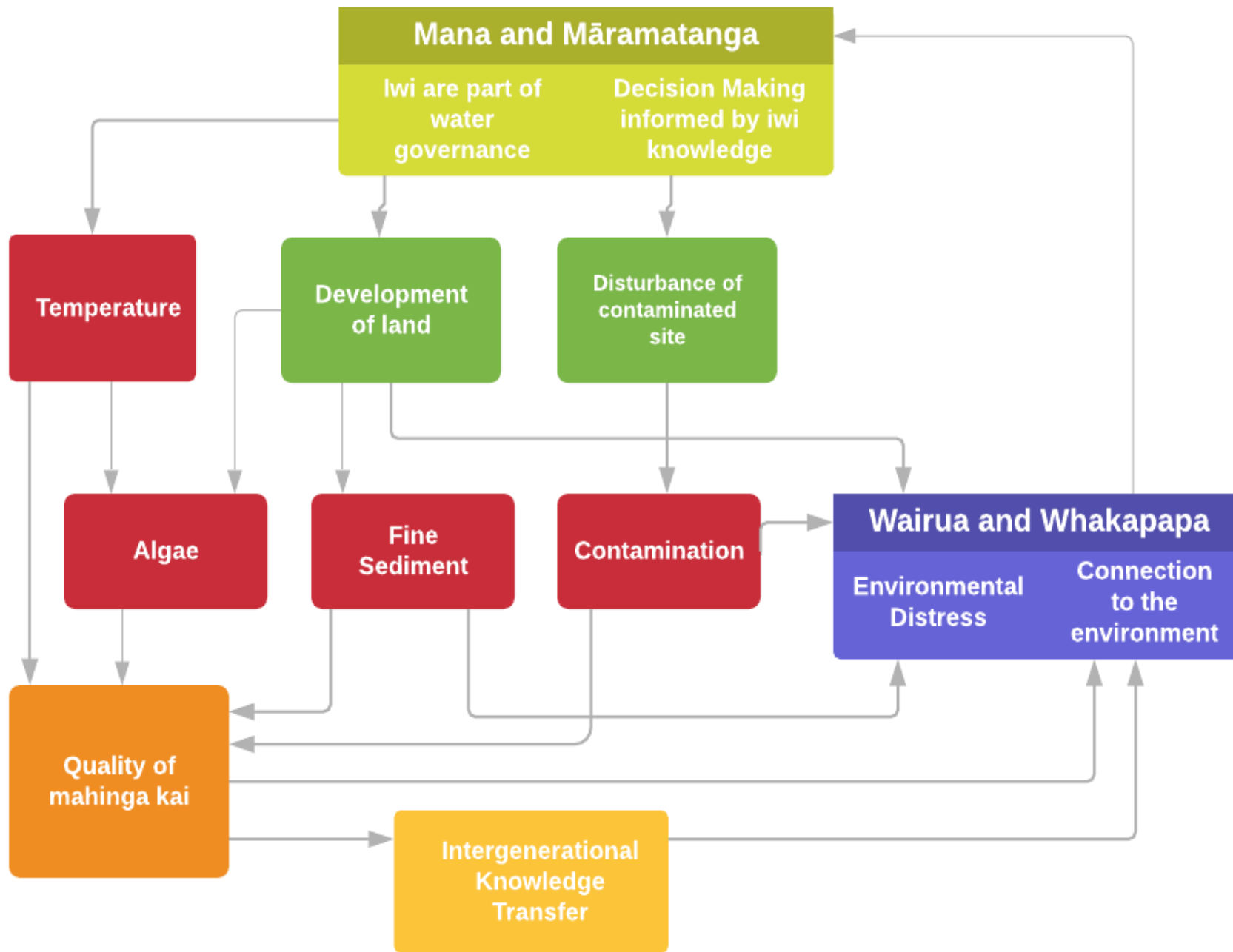

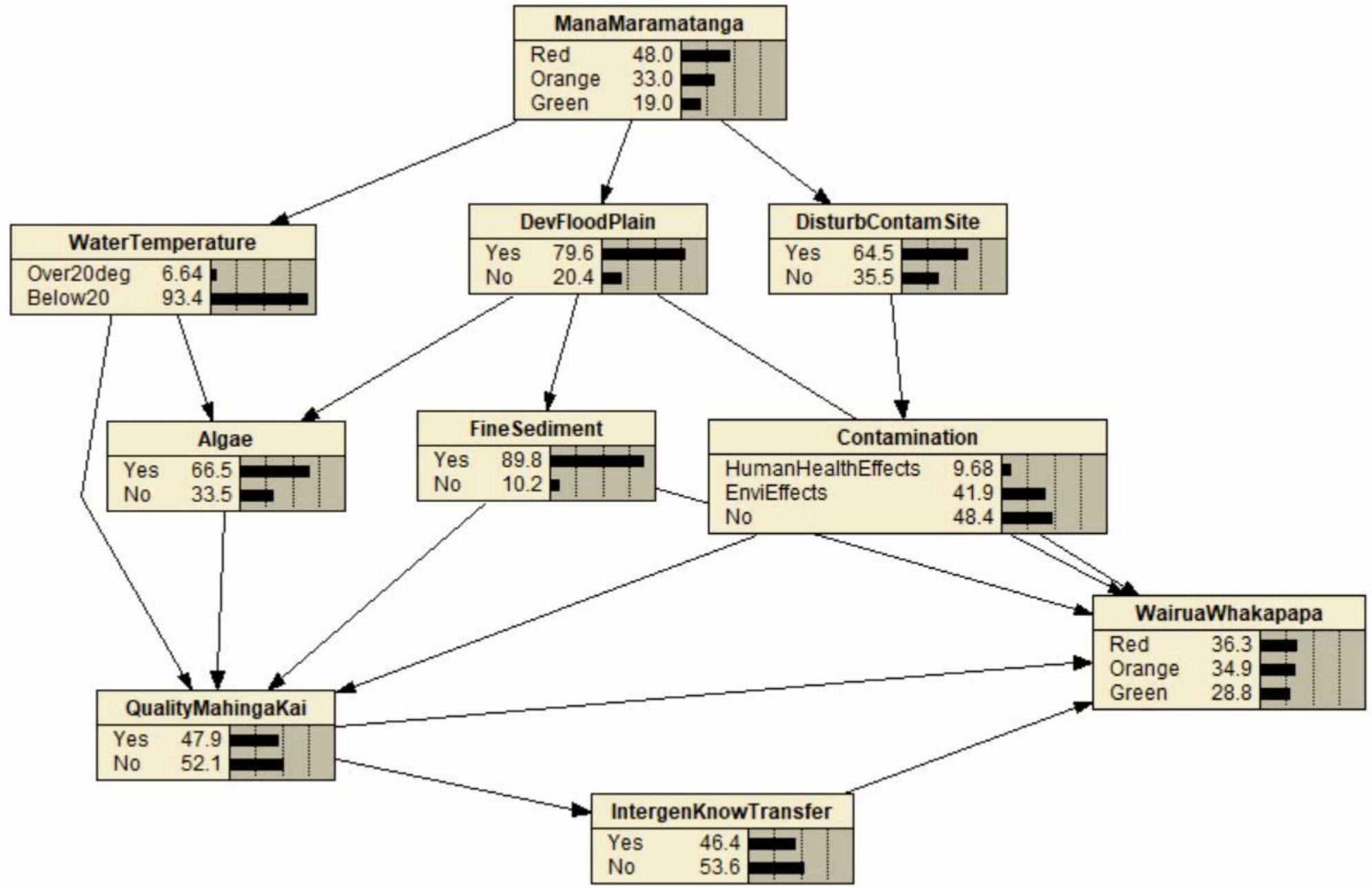
