

Project Manager - Environmental Policy

We are looking for an experienced project manager to join our Environmental Policy team to manage the review of Tasman's resource management plans. This is a fixed-term role for three years with scope for the term to be extended. Tasman's resource management plans provide a blueprint for where and how our communities will grow and how we look after our environment. We are currently in year two of a ten-year project to produce a new plan. The new plan will need to be current, reflect community values and meet our legal obligations.

The primary purpose of this role will be to coordinate and manage the multiple workstreams that will form the new plan. With so many moving parts the project manager will be responsible for ensuring the team knows what they need to do and by when. There is also a prescribed legal process to be followed with a number of statutory deadlines to be met. You will work directly with the Environmental Policy Manager and Policy Team Leaders to develop and implement a project plan, including timelines, deliverables, task allocation and resourcing needs for the overall project.

You will bring to the role high energy, enthusiasm and commitment while possessing a thorough knowledge of local government, RMA processes and policy development. We envisage you will have a PM qualification and significant experience managing large, multi-year projects and.
